# INTRODUCTION

Integrity Systems Company is working with industry supply chain partners to fast-track the uptake of digital consignments for livestock movements through the Livestock Production Assurance eNVD.

ISC has created an innovative eNVD mobile app to overcome connectivity challenges that had been holding back adoption of digital consignments. The eNVD is a digital form which supports end-to-end electronic transfer of livestock consignments including LPA NVDs, Meat Standards Australia Vendor Declarations, National Health Declarations and National Feedlot Accreditation Scheme forms. The eNVD Livestock Consignments app is a complete mobile solution which works offline, and will save time and prevent errors.

# THE NEW eNVD APP

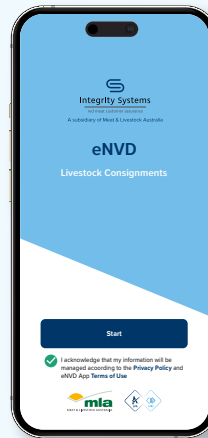
The eNVD app is a completely mobile, offline solution for livestock consignments.

It creates the opportunity for eNVD to be adopted along the entire supply chain journey, from producer to transporter, saleyard, feedlot and to the processor, saving time and preventing errors.

The app allows transfer of a consignment from a producer's mobile device to a transporter or receiver's mobile device using QR codes – without mobile coverage.

Users can easily change between using the eNVD website platform and the mobile app – new consignments created on the website will be available in the app, and vice versa.

The app is available for download for free through the Apple Store and Google Play Store.

eNVD is the fast, easy system for completing all livestock consignment forms digitally.

It is available to all producers, feedlots and value chain stakeholders accredited through Livestock Production Assurance (LPA). The eNVD mobile app is a complete mobile solution, works offline and will save time and prevent errors. The app enables the transfer of information along the entire supply chain - from producer to transporter, saleyard, feedlot and processor.

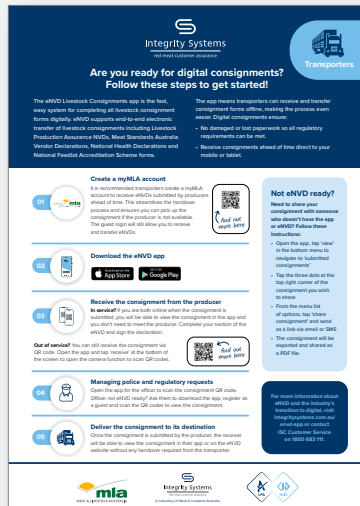

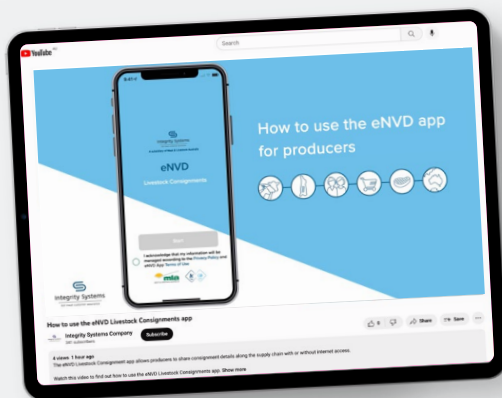

### How to create a new myMLA account and link your integrity system accounts

myMLA is the gateway to access a range of MLA products and services and provides a single sign on facility to your NLS, LPA, NLS, LPA, and MSA accounts. The myMLA dashboard delivers personalised, relevant content that's unique to each user, based on their pre-determined preferences. Follow these easy steps to sign up to myMLA and link your integrity system accounts.

- From the myMLA homepage, click on the 'myMLA sign up' button in the top right corner.
- You will see this page. Click on the 'Sign up to myMLA' button.
- Enter your email address and a password for your new myMLA account then click 'Continue'.
- You will then be asked to enter a code. An email has been sent to your nominated email address with a verification code.

### How to verify an existing myMLA Account

To ensure the security of your data, you are required to verify your account the next time you login to myMLA. Follow these steps to complete the verification process.

- From the myMLA homepage, click on the 'myMLA sign up' button in the top right corner.
- You will see this page. Click on the 'Log in to myMLA' button.
- Enter your email address and password to login to your myMLA account. Then click 'Continue'.
- You will then be asked to enter a code. An email has been sent to your nominated email address with a verification code.

### eNVD app: how to create a digital consignment

Producers

Before using the eNVD Livestock Consignments app, ensure you have registered for a myMLA account and your integrity system accounts are linked to that account. If you're not sure how, find out here: [www.integritysystems.com.au/link-mymla](http://www.integritysystems.com.au/link-mymla)

- Login to the app using your myMLA login details.
- There are two options for creating a consignment - 'Create from template' or 'Create from scratch'. If you are not the owner you can search the app's Property Identification Code (PIC) register for the owner's details or input them manually. Location fees are missing from.
- Select the species you are consigning. Tap on the 'Create' button in the bottom menu.
- Complete the consignment details for the livestock being consigned. The first screen includes:
  - Species of livestock
  - Property Identification Code (PIC) register for the owner's details or input them manually
  - Location fees are missing from.

### eNVD app: how to share a digital consignment

Producers

There are two ways to share a digital consignment with a transporter. If you are both online from the same device or are connected when the consignment is submitted, the transporter from the app will set up with a myMLA login. The transporter will be able to view any consignment submitted to their registered email address. This allows the transporter to view the consignment details and share the consignment with their transporter. The transporter needs to complete their section of the eNVD and sign the declaration before commencing the journey. One of the benefits of the eNVD Livestock Consignments app is the ability to transfer consignments when there is no mobile signal or if the transporter is not registered for myMLA. These steps explain how to share a consignment with a transporter or offline, via QR code.

- If you have just completed the declaration, you will see an option to 'Share transporter details'.
- If you need to enter details for a shared consignment, tap on 'Share My Details' and on the transporter details section. From here, tap 'Share' on the transporter details section.
- Add the transporter's registered email address. If you are the livestock owner and transporter, then please, complete the details including name, vehicle registration number and phone number. Otherwise, leave these fields blank. When the transporter logs in to their device, they can view the consignment in their transporter list. Tap the '+' to add additional transporters if the livestock are being moved more than one transporter and enter each transporter's registered email address. Tap 'Next' once complete.
- From the Summary screen, tap the 'Share' button. The consignment has been successfully transferred to the transporter. The transporter will receive an email with the consignment details including name, phone number, vehicle registration number, date and time of movement and sign the declaration before leaving the property.

### eNVD app: how to create and use a template

Producers

One of the benefits of using the eNVD Livestock Consignments app is the ability to create templates for regular consignments, saving you time when the address details, forms or livestock types are the same from consignment to consignment.

- Tap on the 'Create Template' button in the bottom menu.
- Tap the three dots '...' next to the consignment you wish to use as a template.
- Tap 'Create Template' and name the template. Tap 'Create'.
- To create a consignment using the template, tap the 'Create' button in the bottom menu. Then tap 'Select Template'.

### eNVD app: digital consignments for transporters

Transporters

Before using the eNVD Livestock Consignments app, it is recommended transporters create a myMLA account to receive eNVDs submitted by producers prior to the journey. This streamlines the hardware process and ensures you can pick up the consignment if the producer is not available. If you are not the owner you can search the app's Property Identification Code (PIC) register for the owner's details or input them manually. Location fees are missing from.

The good thing is that you will receive and transfer eNVDs. There are two ways a digital consignment can be shared with you - when you are in mobile coverage or outside mobile coverage. This guide also explains how to share a consignment using QR code and sharing a consignment outside the app.

- Option 1: Receiving a consignment when in mobile coverage
  - Activate the producer of your registered myMLA email address. The producer creates and submits a consignment with your registered email address. This consignment will be visible in your eNVD app and will also be visible to the destination (provided you have the Property Identification Code (PIC)).
- Option 2: Receiving a consignment when outside mobile coverage
  - Tap on the consignment then scroll down to the Transporter section. Tap 'Share My Details' to complete your name, vehicle registration number, date and time of movement. You also need to tick and sign the declaration.

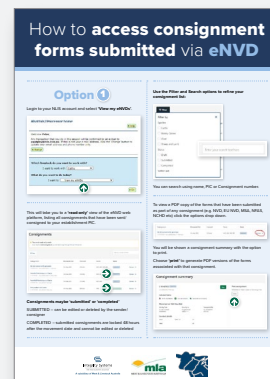
# RESOURCES – ACCESSING eNVDs FOR THE SUPPLY CHAIN

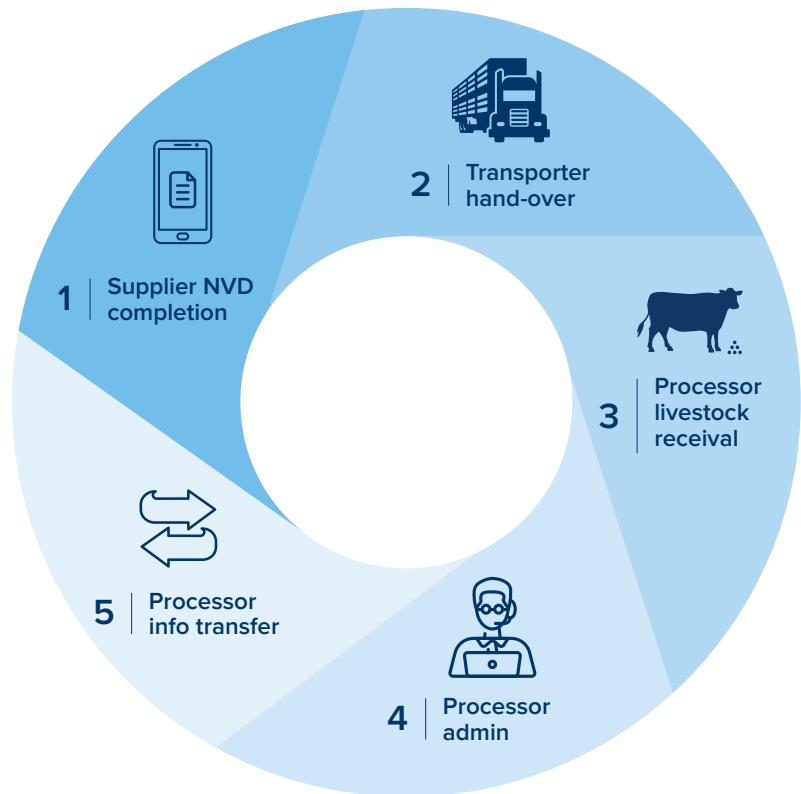
