









Red meat export value



Heavy Lamb Indicator





Market update - Key takeaways

- Producer confidence is high given positive weather outlook, back to back good seasons and increase in international demand
- Despite lower export volumes (particularly beef), higher prices are holding up value
- Prices expected to remain at historically high levels
- Lamb production is solid with more to come, with strong US and China demand
- Mutton prices are nearing record heights
- Domestic cattle market is at it's highest point ever
- Australia continue to outpace other key exporters on price despite global prices lifting
- Global beef trading dynamic is evolving and should be monitored closely










A. LPA ... your account and (re)accreditation

- Access and update your account through myMLA: www.mymla.com.au
- For new and renewing producers, keep your knowledge up-to-date by completing the LPA Learning Modules
- LPA-accredited producers will need to renew accreditation by completing an assessment every three years
- If your LPA accreditation lapses, you cannot access NVDs
- Saleyards will check to see if your LPA accreditation is up to date












How to complete LPA accreditation

- For new LPA accounts, the LPA learning will need to be completed.
- For re-accreditation, the welfare module must be re-completed to generate a new animal welfare certificate
- All learning modules should be completed to ensure you are up to date with any changes which may have occurred since the last assessment













How to complete LPA accreditation

- Commit to using the eNVD for either all or some consignments and you will be eligible for a discount of \$30 on your accreditation fee
- Follow the instructions to access the eNVD and the discount

LPA tips for selling livestock

- Ensure record keeping is up to date so you can properly complete your NVDs
- Check all livestock you are planning to sell have a working NLIS device
- Ensure livestock are fit to load
- Make sure every NVD is clear, complete and correct or use eNVD for a faster, easier way to complete your consignments
- Make sure the movement has been recorded on the NLIS database









Record keeping for LPA

- There is no perfect formula when it comes to record keeping.
- Regardless of the method, it is important that all relevant management activities are accurately and clearly recorded
- Your LPA records will be reviewed by an auditor, so it's important to make sure they are accurate and up to date
- Keep records of all staff inductions and trainings

HOW TO: Create or upload documents in your LPA account

Managing records in order to maintain your LPA Accreditation just got simpler!

- Property risk assessment and biosecurity plans can now be completed and saved online
- · Templates for other essential LPA documents are available to download
- All LPA records can be stored online within your LPA account.

Good records provide the information required to correctly complete your NVDs, are essential in the event of a biosecurity or animal disease incident and are required for LPA audits.











Animal identification

- All animals leaving a property must be identified with an NLIS accredited tag or device before moving
- Once tagged, the tag should remain with the animal for life
- If it stops working/falls out, the animal needs to be tagged with a post-breeder device to maintain traceability
- Cattle must be tagged with an electronic (RFID) device
- Sheep and goats must be tagged with an NLIS accredited ear tag or device (check your state's requirements)

Livestock transportation

- Livestock must not be stressed or injured prior to loading
- Producers must adhere to maximum time off water requirements and pre-consignment curfews
- Choose transport operators who operate in accordance with a recognised quality assurance program: www.trucksafe.com.au
- Inspect vehicles prior to livestock transportation








LPA NVDs – what producers need to do

- Maintain your LPA accreditation to access LPA NVDs.
- NVDs are a legal document. When ticking boxes on an LPA NVD, it declares your on-farm practices meet LPA requirements ... and customers' expectations.
- A tick on an NVD needs to be backed up by accurate farm records. This is a pledge that meat has been produced safely, ethically and meets biosecurity requirements – it means you stand by what you sell.
- File your completed NVDs in case of audit. NLIS transfers are part of LPA audits.








LPA NVDs – top compliance issues

- ✓ Handwritten NVDs are not legible.
- ✓ NVDs are not completed, ie, questions missed
- NVDs are not signed
- ✓ NVDs have both 'yes' and 'no' ticked, instead of one or the other
- The NVD form has been photocopied from a hard copy book or a sample NVD downloaded from the internet.
- Use of white-out to correct a mistake on a form. If mistakes are made, start the form again.










NLIS – what producers need to do

- Keep your online NLIS account details up-to-date
- Order and use NLIS tags for every animal on your PIC
- Record movements of livestock in the NLIS database. The timeframes for property to property transfers vary so check what is required for your state.
- Regularly compare your records to the NLIS database to ensure transfers are completed
- Do a PIC reconciliation if there are differences. If ISC emails you about these, investigate the error.







Recording livestock movements through NLIS

- You must record all livestock movements onto your PIC on the NLIS database to remain LPA-accredited.
- If livestock are bought, sold or moved through saleyard, the movement must be recorded by the saleyard
- For private sales, the receiver must record the livestock movement
- The vendor is not obligated to record the movement, although they may do so
- All livestock consignments must be accompanied by a form of movement documentation

INTEGRITY INSIGHT

State legislation also requires that the buyer or receiver of the livestock completes the transfer on the NLIS database.

Penalties may be imposed by your state or territory government for failing to complete these transfers as required.

1. What is a PIC reconciliation?

A PIC Reconciliation is a stocktake of all electronic cattle devices on a property. This process identifies discrepancies between the **total** number of electronic devices **physically on** a property, and the number of electronic devices **registered to** that property (PIC) on the NLIS Database. At the end of the







Integrity Insights – NLIS

What is early warning status?

- Early warning is a status within the NLIS database automatically assigned to a property carrying high-risk animals
- While it doesn't identify specific animals, it helps monitor and manage biosecurity risk for your farm and food safety along the supply chain.
- Statuses are listed on the NLIS database.

How to use the Early Warning status (producers)

Early Warning (EW) is a status within the National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) database that is automatically assigned to a **property** carrying a high-risk animal or animals.

The EW status does not identify what the status is for, or which specific animals are high-risk.

The EW status helps monitor and manage food safety and biosecurity risk along the entire supply chain.







