eNVD is the fast, easy system for completing all livestock consignment forms. The eNVD app means producers can complete and transfer consignment forms offline, plus ...

- Create templates for regular livestock movements
- Answer questions once-only to fill out all forms
- Securely store documents, always available online
- Always use the latest NVD versions

Download the eNVD app and login using your myMLA account details or login to the web platform via myMLA



### Not eNVD ready?

You can now share digital consignments with anyone.

#### APP:

- Tap 'view' in the bottom menu to see 'submitted consignments'
- Tap the three dots (top right corner)
- Select 'Share URL' to send a link via email or SMS, or 'Generate PDF' to download a copy

#### WEB:

- Select 'Options' on relevant consignment and select 'Generate PDF' to download and share a copy

Confirm your transporter is ready to receive digital consignments

If they're not using eNVD, share this link to help them get set up.

Confirm the destination is ready to receive digital consignments

You need to confirm the destination PIC as this cannot be edited on the eNVD once the consignment is submitted.

After submission, the receiver can view the consignment by logging into their eNVD.

Create your first consignment in the app

Transfer the consignment to your transporter

**In service?** If you are both online when the consignment is submitted, and the transporter has the app set-up with a myMLA login, the transporter should be able to view the consignment in the app and can complete their section of the eNVD.

**Out of service?** The transporter can still receive the consignment via QR code. Tap the 'share consignment' button at the bottom of the consignment to open the QR codes and start the transfer process. Once the consignment has been received, reopen the app when you have service so it can sync, ensuring your eNVD is in the system before the consignment arrives at its destination.
