The eNVD Livestock Consignments app is the fast, easy system for completing all livestock consignment forms digitally. The eNVD app means producers can complete and transfer consignment forms offline, plus ...

- Create templates for regular livestock movements
- Answer questions once-only to fill out all forms
- Securely store documents, always available online
- Always use the latest NVD versions

### Not eNVD ready?

Need to share your consignment with someone who doesn't have the app or eNVD?

Follow these instructions:

- Open the app, tap 'view' in the bottom menu to navigate to 'submitted consignments'
- Tap the three dots at the top right corner of the consignment you wish to share
- From the menu list of options, tap 'share consignment' and send as a link via email or SMS
- The consignment will be exported and shared as a PDF file.

Confirm your transporter is ready to receive digital consignments

Confirm the destination is ready to receive digital consignments

You also need to confirm the destination PIC as this cannot be edited on the eNVD once the consignment is submitted.

If they're not using eNVD, share this link to help them get set up. Alternatively, you may need to supply a PDF copy.

Create your first consignment in the app

Transfer the consignment to your transporter

**In service?** If you are both online when the consignment is submitted, and the transporter has the app set-up with a myMLA login, the transporter should be able to view the consignment in the app and can complete their section of the eNVD.

**Out of service?** The transporter can still receive the consignment via QR code. Tap the 'share consignment' button at the bottom of the consignment to open the QR codes and start the transfer process. Once the consignment has been received, reopen the app when you have service so it can sync, ensuring your eNVD is in the system before the consignment arrives at its destination.
