EXPLANATORY NOTES – HARVESTED RANGELAND GOAT NATIONAL VENDOR DECLARATION AND WAYBILL

The Livestock Production Assurance (LPA) National Vendor Declaration (NVD) underpins Australia's meat and livestock food safety reputation. When you sign an LPA NVD, you are sharing information on livestock history and declaring compliance with all LPA requirements (www.integritysystems.com.au).

As an LPA accredited producer in the Harvested Rangeland Goat module (HRG Module), you may only provide an LPA Harvested Rangeland Goat NVD for movements of Harvested Rangeland Goats that meet the following definitions.

A Harvested Rangeland Goat is a goat that has been captured from a wild state, that has not been born as a result of a managed breeding program and has not been subjected to any animal husbandry procedure or treatment.

A Harvested Rangeland Goat must not be fed restricted animal materials (including meat and bone meal) while under your control.

A Harvested Rangeland Goat may only be moved without an NLIS approved identification device from the property of capture directly to an abattoir for slaughter or to one Registered Goat Depot.

Any goat that does not meet the definition of a Harvested Rangeland Goat must be identified with a NLIS approved identification device and moved using the LPA NVD/Waybill for Goats.

A **Registered Goat Depot** is a property that is used to aggregate Harvested Rangeland Goats prior to sale and/or slaughter. Registered Goat Depots adhere to the conditions in the Industry NLIS Standards for

Operating a Goat Depot and are approved by a state or territory.

A Registered Goat Depot must also be accredited in the LPA HRG Module and use the LPA HRG NVD to move Harvested Rangeland Goats without an NLIS identification device from the Registered Goat Depot direct to an abattoir for slaughter.

Your Responsibility - All answers must be accurate. Any false, misleading or unverified statements may result in prosecution or civil action. Before signing you must be absolutely satisfied that you understand and have correctly completed all parts of the LPA HRG NVD.

The hardcopy LPA HRG NVD document is in triplicate.

- **Top (white) sheet** – Purchaser copy
- **Middle (green sheet)** – Carrier Copy
- **Bottom (pink) sheet** – Vendor Copy. This copy MUST be filed for auditing purposes.

PART A

Part A must be completed by the person who is consigning the Harvested Rangeland Goats from a property (PIC) that is accredited in the LPA HRG Module.

The property/place where the journey commenced is the address of the location where the movement commenced.

The Property Identification Code (PIC) of the HRG Goat Accredited Property is the PIC of the property where:

- Harvested Rangeland goats were captured and are transported direct to an abattoir for slaughter or to one registered goat depot only OR
- the PIC of a Registered Goat Depot that is accredited in the LPA Harvested Rangeland Goat module.

Total Number of Harvested Rangeland Goats is the number of goats being moved.

Consigned to - provide the name and full physical address of the person and/or company the goats are being consigned to.

Destination - if the destination where goats are physically moving to is different to the 'consigned to' provide the full physical address of the destination of the goats.

Destination PIC - is the PIC of the destination which you intend to consign the goats to.

Question 1 – confirm that all goats in the consignment meet the Harvested Rangeland Goat definition.

If all goats in the consignment do not meet the Harvested Rangeland Goat definition they are not eligible to move on a LPA HRG NVD. Ineligible goats must be NLIS identified and moved on an LPA NVD for Goats.

Declaration - Signing this declaration has legal significance. Regulatory authorities may take legal action, and purchasers may seek damages, if any information in Part A is incorrect. You must be absolutely satisfied you understand all elements of

the document and these explanatory notes.

Restricted Animal Material includes any tissue, blood or other material taken from an animal and any meals derived from animals. Examples include meat and bone meals, blood meal, fish meal, and feather meal. It does not include tallow, gelatine or milk products. www.integritysystems.com.au

Signature – the LPA HRG NVD must be signed and dated to be deemed a valid LPA HRG NVD.

PART B

Part B must be completed by the carrier (or driver of the transport) where applicable in the states/territories that require waybills.

This waybill is valid for one journey only e.g. from the vendor's property to a registered goat depot.

A separate waybill must be completed for any subsequent journey, e.g. from registered goat depot to abattoir.

When more than one truck is carrying the goats all vehicle registration numbers are to be recorded.

If there is insufficient space to record all the vehicle registration numbers, the Attachment to NVD form should be used and attached to all copies of the NVD. Some state regulatory authorities will require a copy of the LPA NVD / waybill to travel with each individual vehicle. If any information is incorrect regulatory authorities may take legal action.
