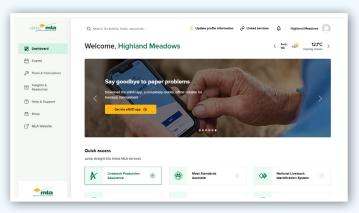
Submit evidence for your LPA remote audit

How-to Guide

Producers may be randomly selected to participate in a random audit remotely rather than an on-farm audit. This how-to guide outlines the steps to submit evidence to your LPA account.

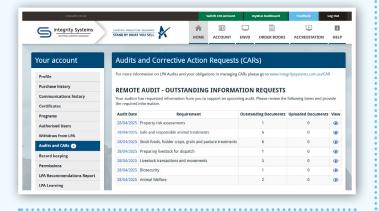
Login to myMLA and navigate to your LPA account.



If you have agreed to participate in a remote audit, you will see this message on the home screen. Click on 'Upload Documents' to view the 'Audits and Corrective Action Requests (CARs)' page.

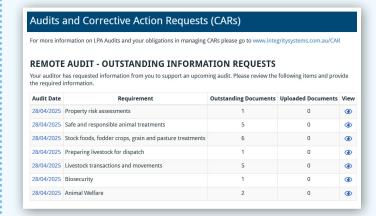


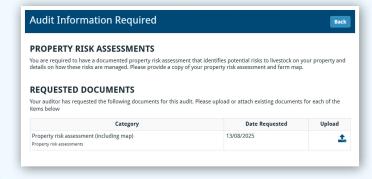
You can also access the 'Audits and Corrective Action Requests (CARs)' page by clicking the link in your Audit Notification email, or by navigating to 'Account' in the top menu, then selecting 'Audits and CARs' from the left-hand menu.



The 'Remote Audit - Outstanding Information Requests' table lists all the documents the auditor has requested.

Click on each item to see the individual documents which need to be uploaded.





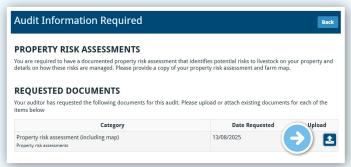


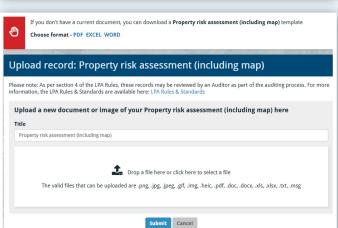


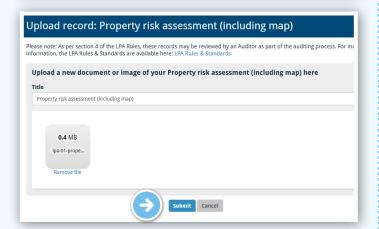


Click on the **'Upload'** icon next to a requested document. Drag and drop the relevant file or click to upload it. You can add multiple files at a time. Make any edits to the titles of the documents if required, then click **'Submit'**.

Note: You can upload image file types (png, jpg, jpeg, gif, img, heic) or document file types (pdf, doc, docx, xls, xlsx, txt, msg).



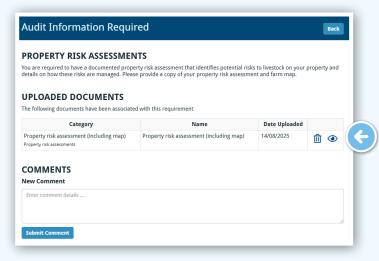




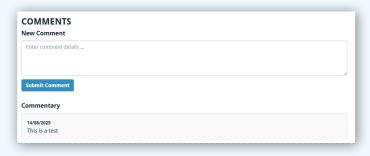
Important information regarding the requested document will be displayed at the top of the 'Upload record' page. This includes whether there are ISC templates available (PDF, Excel, Word) that you can download to use for your farm records.

If you don't have a current document, you can download a Livestock treatment records template Choose format - PDF EXCEL WORD

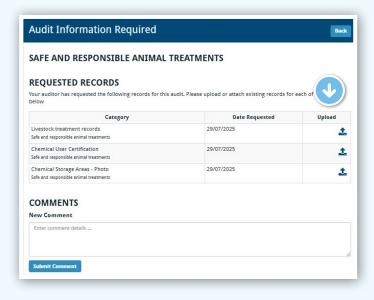
A list of the documents you have uploaded is shown on the next screen. Click the eye icon to view the uploaded document or the rubbish bin icon to delete the file.



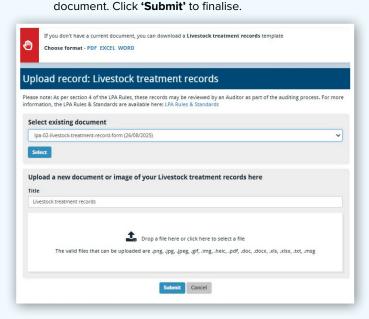
You can add comments for the auditor – all submitted comments will be displayed in a list below the
'Comments' box. An email will also be sent to the auditor at the end of each day with a summary of any comments.



You can also link a document you have previously added to the 'Record keeping' folder in your LPA account. On the 'Remote Audit - Outstanding Information Requests' table, click on the requirement for the document being requested and click the 'Upload' button.



At the top of the screen, there is an option to **'Select** existing document'. Use the dropdown to select the existing document, then click **'Select'** to link the



Once you are happy with all the documents you have uploaded for that section and have added any relevant comments, click 'Back' or 'Audits and CARs' in the left-hand menu. You will be redirected to the 'Audits and Corrective Action Requests (CARs)' page.
