Beast enquiries report

This report allows you to check the European Union status of cattle (Yes, No or Deceased). Producers may also view the Lifetime Traceable (LT) status of their livestock (Yes or No). Abattoir, Agent, Saleyard, SDA and SDA Medium users also have the Complete beast **enquiry** report to view other statuses that may be associated with livestock devices.

The beast enquiries report is also useful if you know the visual NLISID numbers printed on tags, but need the electronic RFID numbers, or vice versa. If the tags are registered to a PIC linked to your database account, the results show the current PIC, RFID, NLISID, EU status and LT status (Producers can see LT).

If the tags were previously registered to your PIC, only the RFID and NLISID are shown. If the tags were **never registered** to your PIC, you see 'You are not authorised to view information for the device.'

Login to the database at www.nlis.com.au

- Once logged in, select the livestock type (if not displayed).
- Select **Beast enquiries** and click Go
- Financial third parties select View/generate all reports > EU devices > Beast enquiries
- Enter the **NLISID** or **RFID** numbers of the tags.
- Click Go to display the report results.
